- The **UK Biobank** timeline has been enhanced with several questionnaires, focused on topics such as social interactions and pain 
- Waves 14 and 15 of **Understanding Society**, covering a wide range of ages and life stages 
- Round 11 of the **European Social Survey** conducted across 2023 and 2024 
- The 2024 sweep of the **European Working Conditions Survey** 
- Multiple sweeps across **Born in Bradford** and **Born in Bradford's Better Start**, including COVID questionnaires and primary school years
